







What is the Rise to the Occasion Challah Bake event?

Chal-lah • Hebrew: חלה Halla. Noun: the term challah is applied to special bread used in jewish rituals and on holidays.

Challah is a special bread that is usually braided or round and is used on the Sabbath, Holidays, and in religious ceremonies.

The Emunah Rise to the Occasion Challah Bake is an interactiveinterfaith event bringing together the Christian community and the Jewish community. A night of making and breaking bread together!

Challah is one of the mitzvot (commandments) that is a beautiful synthesis of spirituality and physicality. At this event participants will enjoy rituals, prayers and dance, make their own challah to take home, and learn the religious significance of Challah.

Emunah is a non-profit social action organization in Israel transforming the lives of Israel's most vulnerable and at-risk children and families through the power of faith and love.

It is incumbent on all, to RISE TO THE OCCASION and make a difference in this world and for the children in Israel.

combines professional training with Jewish values. The center prepares educators to work in the fields of marriage counseling, healthy sexuality, parenting and gerontology.



Emunah High Schools

provide quality and diverse education, offering a variety of courses, which include art, drama, music, computer technology, biomedical engineering, and Torah studies.



Emunah Promotes Women's Status

in the public arena and in the rabbinical court and vigorously support legislation in the Knesset advancing the rights of women and families in Israel.

offers unique learning opportunities for religious young women to earn a degree in the fields of fine arts, Graphic design, drama and Jewish studies.




Emunah Maayan Rivka Golden Age Restaurant
