Kingdom Principle:

"But beware of the false prophets who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly they are savage wolves. By their fruits you shall know them." Matthew 7:15-16

"See I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Therefore be wise as serpents and innocent as doves." Matthew 10:16

"Son of man, prophesy against the Shepherds of Israel, prophesy and say to them, "Thus says the Master Yahweh, to the shepherds, "Woe to the shepherds of Israel who have been feeding themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flock? You eat the fat and put on the wool. You slaughter the fatlings—you do not feed the flock. You have not strengthened the weak, nor have you healed the sick, nor bound up the broken, nor brought back the straying, nor sought what was lost, but you have ruled them with might and with harshness."
